THE COUNTY GROUND STADIUM

Visiting supporters:

Visiting supporters will be primarily located in the Arkells stand, the capacity of which is 1,314 (but the number can vary on segregation).

We also have an overflow section in the Stratton Bank which holds 2,272 .

We have 10 available wheelchair spaces for away supporters located at the front of the stand in a covered section.

There is limited spaces for match day car parking. If you would like to enquire about a space, please contact reception@swindontownfc.co.uk at the earliest convenience to avoid disappointment.





HOW TO GET HERE

TRAVELLING FROM THE EAST AND WEST:

Leave the M4 at Junction 15. Take the Commonhead Roundabout. Turn left onto the A4259 Marlborough RD. Take the second exit at the roundabout onto Queens Drive. At the next set of roundabouts take the third exit onto County RD. The entrance to the County Ground is the first right.

TRAVELLING FROM THE MIDLANDS:

Take the M40 to Junction 9. Take the A43, A34 then on the A420 into Swindon. At Drakes roundabout, turn into Queens Drive. At the next set of roundabouts, take the third exit onto County RD, the stadium entrance is the first right.

TRAVELLING BY BUS:

Queens Drive and Fleming Way are the nearest roads with bus stops. Buses that stop here are numbers 1A, 5, 13, 14 and 23.

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN:

From the front of Swindon station turn left into Station Rd. Facing the White House PH head right into Corporation Street. At the traffic lights turn left onto Manchester Rd. At the end of Manchester Rd turn right into County Rd. The entrance to the stadium is the second left. Walking distance appx. ten minutes.



FOOD DRINK AND REFRESHMENTS

In the away concourse situated in the Arkells, we have a kiosk serving hot food and drinks, with cold beverages also available – until 15 minutes into the second half of the game.

Please note – payments are now cashless in the away end.

IN THE AREA:

Local food establishments such as Burger King, Magic chippy, the Merlin, Nandos, Tesco café are all within a 10 minute walk of the County Ground.



OTHER HANDY INFORMATION

TICKET OFFICE/SHOP OPENING TIMES:

The ticket office and club shop is open 11am-KO (Saturdays for a 3pm ko) and 45 minutes after the full-time whistle. Open from 12pm-KO (Evening game). Away ticket office open from 1:30pm-KO/6:30-KO, card only.

MATCH PROGRAMMES:

Programmes are available to buy on the day of the fixture from away ticket office and sellers around the stadium. They are also on sale in the club shop, priced £4.

NEAREST CASHPOINT:

There are a number of cashpoints close to the ground should you need it. Tesco just round the corner from the Arkells offer free withdrawal. As does Aldi and the Post Office the opposite side of the Magic Roundabout to the County Ground.
