THE COUNTY GROUND STADIUM

The Away section is located at the far end of the Arkells Stand. It has a capacity of 900 supporters.

We have 10 available wheelchair spaces for away supporters at the Energy Check County Ground, located at the front of the stand in a covered section. One ticket allows 1 x wheelchair user and a complimentary carer access to the ground. There will be 3 tickets included in your ticket allocation but if you require anymore do get in touch.

GETTING HERE

TRAVELLING FROM THE EAST AND WEST >>

Leave the M4 at Junction 15. Take the Commonhead Roundabout. Turn left onto the A4259 Marlborough Road. Take the 2nd exit at the roundabout onto Queens Drive. At the next set of roundabouts take the 3rd exit onto County Road. The entrance to the ground is on the first right.

TRAVELLING FROM THE MIDLANDS >>

Take the M40 to Junction 9. Then take the A43, A34 and then the A420 into Swindon. At Drakes' Roundabout turn onto Queen's Drive. At the next set of roundabouts take the 3rd exit onto County Road, the entrance to the stadium is the first right.

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN >>

From the front of the station turn left onto Station Road.
Facing the White House pub, head right onto Corporation Street. At the traffic lights turn left onto Manchester Road. At the end of Manchester Road turn right onto County Road. The entrance to the stadium is the second left. This walk should take approximately 10 minutes.

PARKING >>

There are limited spaces available at The County Ground at a cost of £10, but there are several Town centre car parks situated half a mile from the stadium. There is nearby street parking and several match day car parks. Parking for home fans is also available at Drove Primary School for £5.

BANNERS, FLAGS & SIGNS

SWINDON TOWN FOOTBALL CLUB

WANTS TO ENCOURAGE AN EXCITING ATMOSPHERE AT ALL GAMES PLAYED AT THE COUNTY GROUND STADIUM AND ENCOURAGES FANS TO BRING FLAGS, BANNERS & LARGE 'SURFING' FLAGS - BUT THESE MUST ADHERE TO THE GUIDELINES SET BY THE STADIUM'S SAFETY TEAM.

Flags, Surfers & Banners - General

- SwindonTownFootballClubreservesthe right to refuse to allow flags, surfers or banners to be displayed, particularly if content is considered offensive, discriminatory, defamatory or inflammatory.
- Any item that Swindon Town Football Club or any of its employees believe could potentially be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety is strictly prohibited and will be confiscated.

Flags

Flags should be no bigger than 150cm in 6 depth or width. Flags should
be presented to stewards prior to entry to the Stadium where they will be
inspected and approved prior to entry. Anything above these measurements
will be classed as a banner and will therefore require a fire certificate and will
need to be registered with the Club.





BANNERS, FLAGS & SIGNS

Banners

- Materials measuring more than 150cm x 150cm will be considered as banners.
- All banners and surfers should be made from, or treated with, fireretardant material and a fire certificate must be produced. Proof of certification may be required whenever they are brought into the stadium.
- On occasion, where a Club designated sterile area (e.g. empty block of seats) is available within Stadium, it may be possible for banners to be placed in the sterile area. Permission to do so must first be obtained from the Club in advance via email at mark@swindontownfc.co.uk or, in circumstances where this is not possible, by the stand manager prior to entry on a matchday.
